Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under

Section-392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner is not named but in course of investigation,

one co-accused, confessed his guilt, disclosing the name of the
petitioner and, after that, the petitioner was arrested and was
remanded in this case on 01-11-2014 but he was not put on TIP.

No doubt, the petitioner does have criminal
antecedent of several cases but taking note of the materials,
available in the present case as well as his period of detention in
jail custody, let the petitioner named above, be released on bail on
furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two

sureties of the like amount each in connection with Bodh Gaya
P.S. Case No. 38 of 2014 to the satisfaction of Sri Jigar Sah,
learned Judicial Magistrate-Ist Class, Gaya.
