Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted under
Section 47(a) of the Biihar Excise Amendment Act, 2016.

Allegation against petitioner is that from his possession
Nepali wine has been recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of petitioner that he is in
custody since 2.8.2016. Chargesheet has been submitted against
petitioner. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. No
allegation of tampering of witnesses is alleged against petitioner.
18 litres of Nepali wine is said to have been recovered from the
possession of petitioner. The said recovery is denied by petitioner.
There is no compliance of Section 100 of the Code of Criminal
Procedure.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that petitioner is
named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the
above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond
of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like
amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial

Magistrate, Sitamarhi, in connection with C2/195 of 2016.
