ORAL ORDER

3 19-09-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking bail in
connection with Gaya Rail P.S. Case No. 20 of 2016 registered for
offences under sections 379 of 411 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation has been made that the petitioner snatched
Rs. 6,000/- and tried to flee away, but he was arrested at the spot.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is in custody since 11th February 2016.

Looking to the period of custody, let the petitioner,
Ranjeet Kumar, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of
Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount
each to the satisfaction of Railway Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in

connection with Gaya Rail P.S. Case No. 20 of 2016, subject to the condition that (i) one of the bailors shall be father/mother/wife/son of the petitioner (ii) if the petitioner is found involved in future in similar type of case, the prosecution will be at liberty to make prayer for cancellation of his bail and the court below will pass necessary order, including cancellation of bail (iii) the petitioner would cooperate in the proceeding of the court below. In event of failure to appear on two consecutive dates, the court below will be at liberty to pass the order, including cancellation of bail bonds and (iv) the petitioner will report to Gaya Rail P.S. Case No. 20 of 2016 by 7th of every month at least for six months and in case of failure without any valid rhyme or reason, the bail of the petitioner will be treated to have been cancelled.
