Heard Mr. J.K. Verma, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Ratan Kumar Sinha, learned counsel appearing for the plaintiff-opposite party in the limitation matter (I.A. No. 4795 of 2014).

Earlier notice was issued in the limitation matter to the plaintiff-opposite parties and they are now being represented by Mr. Ratan Kumar Sinha.
