2 17-11-2016 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.
Sanjay Kumar Singh, learned APP for the State.

Petitioner prays for bail in Industrial Area P.S.Case
No.171 of 2014 registered under Sections 394 and 307 of the IPC.

On going through the First Information Report, it appears
that the accused persons riding a motorcycle in a planned manner,
robbed a bag containing two lacs and odd amount under threat to
life inasmuch as firings were resorted firstly to deter the informant
and then to the persons of the locality who offered chase to the
motorcycle on which the accused made their escape good.

Contention of the petitioner is that there has been no
recovery of stolen cash inasmuch as he is not named in the first

information report. Petitioner is in custody since 17.03.2016.

Mr. Sanjay Kumar Singh, learned Additional P.P. opposed the prayer and submits that not only in course of investigation, the witnesses have supported the prosecution case but also the petitioner has criminal antecedent of having committed offence of identical nature.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the Court is not inclined to extend him the privilege of bail. Prayer is, accordingly, rejected.

However, the petitioner may renew his prayer for bail, if the trial is not concluded within seven months from the date of receipt/communication of the order.
