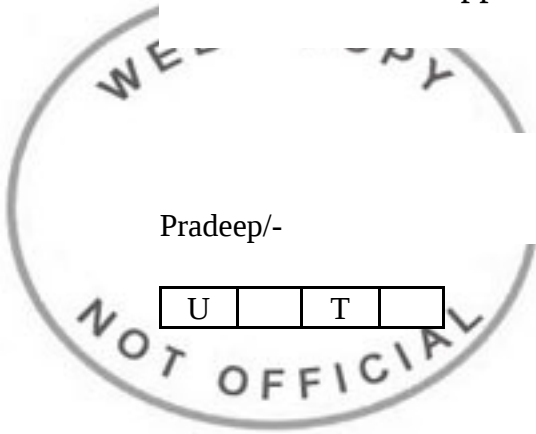
4 27-06-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

By way of the present application preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks quashing of the FIR of Dhoraiya P.S. Case No. 40 of 2013 registered under Sections 467, 468, 471, 420, 120-B and 171-G of the Indian Penal Code.
