3 19-11-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 09.07.2016 in
connection with Garhpura P.S. Case No. 42 of 2016 registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 387 and 506 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner
has been falsely implicated in this case and the mobile number
which is alleged to have been used for demand of rangdari, does
not belong to the petitioner. Furthermore, his name has come on
the confessional statement made before the police by one Baidnath
Paswan which has no evidentiary value.

Considering the nature of allegation made and that the

mobile alleged to have been used does not belong to the petitioner, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-IV, Begusarai in connection with Garhpura P.S. Case No.42 of 2016.
