Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the

Code.

information report but in course of investigation, he was identified
by the victim as well as his mother in Test Identification Parade.

Although, learned counsel appearing for the
petitioner tried to convince me about the reliability and credibility
of Test Identification Parade submitting that aforesaid Test
Identification Parade was held after long delay but I am not, at all,
convinced with the aforesaid submission.
