Heard learned counsels for the petitioner-informant
and the State.

The present application has been filed for
cancellation of bail, granted to opposite party nos. 2 to 4 being
parents and the brother of the husband of the petitioner-informant
vide order dated 09.10.2013 in Criminal Miscellaneous
No.35950/2013 in connection with Kesaria P.S. Case
No.64/2013, pending in the Court of learned CJM, Motihari.

Basic accusation is of torture for non-fulfillment of
dowry demand. The opposite party nos.2 and 4 were granted
anticipatory bail in case registered for the offences punishable
under sections 498A, 341, 323 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal
Code and 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, on submission that
the husband of the petitioner-informant is ready to keep her as

wife with full dignity and honour and the accusation against them is omnibus and general.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner-informant that her husband failed to comply the undertaking given before this Court, though she has not filed any application for cancellation of bail of her husband.

There is nothing on record to suggest that opposite party nos. 2 to 4 have misused the privilege of bail

In view of this Court, the parameters for grant of bail and its cancellation are quite different. Hence, this Court is not inclined to interfere.

Accordingly, the cancellation application is disposed of.
