ORAL ORDER

counsel for the State.

The only direction in the order dated 10.9.2012 under
contempt passed in CWJC No. 16108 of 2012 was that in case the
petitioner files a representation before the Principal Secretary,
General Administration Department, Government of Bihar, then
the same should be disposed of by a reasoned order.

In the show causes filed on behalf of opposite party No.3
and opposite party No.5 the order dated 30.4.2013 of the General
Administration Department has been annexed, by which the

representation of the petitioner has been dismissed.

In the aforesaid circumstances, the order under contempt has been complied with.

The contempt application is, accordingly, dismissed.
