Nine bags of rice, each containing 50 kilograms, of
government supplied, are said to have been recovered from a
tempo on which petitioner was also sitting. Petitioner happens to
be P.D.S dealer and for the aforesaid offence, he is languishing in
jail custody since 06.04.2016 whereas other two co-accused have
already been granted privilege of bail.

Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be
released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two
sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned
Judicial Magistrate 1st class, Gaya in connection with Parriya
P.S.case No. 46 of 2016.
