ORAL ORDER

2 11-08-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned

counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners apprehending their arrest in
connection with Nauhatta P.S. Case No. 24 of 2016 registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 341, 427, 323, 324, 379,
308, 506 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners being the father and sons are the co-
villagers of the informant.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the entire
prosecution case is false and there is no eye-witness to the
occurrence. It is submitted that petitioners have been implicated
due to dirty local politics and all Sections except Sections 308 and
379 of the Indian Penal Code are bailable.

Considering the nature of allegations made, let the petitioners above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saharsa in connection with Nauhatta P.S. Case No. 24 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
