From the pleadings and materials on record, the Court does not come to a conclusion that there is an unambiguous position existing with regard to status of the petitioner as a permanent employee of the College and the University in question having due approval of State under Section 35 of the Universities Act. However, if the petitioner can still produce those illusory materials, which are not on record, before the competent authority of the State authorities, they may still consider the matter afresh.

Writ is dismissed at this juncture with liberty and observation as above.
