Excise Act.

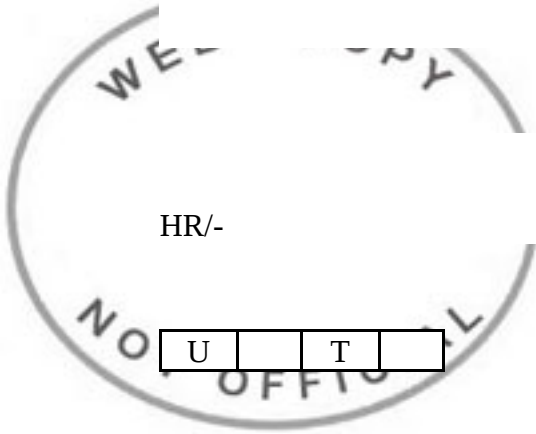
On a raid made, 60 litres of illicit liquor kept in a

arrested at the spot. There is some defect in drawing the
seizure memo. The petitioner is the first offender.

Be that as it may, considering the allegation, in
my view, the petitioner should surrender and seek regular

bail. No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The bail application is disposed of.
