learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The present restoration application has been filed on
account of the fact that notices, which were required to be filed
within a week, could not be filed within the stipulated time,
though filed belatedly and as such, connected Cr.Misc.
No.43659 of 2014 has been dismissed for default for non-
compliance of the order dated 7.5.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there
was a mistake occasioned in the present matter as he came to

weeks.
