counsel for the State.

The petitioner being the husband is apprehending his
arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 1176 of 2011
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498A the
Indian Penal Code.

Earlier notices were issued to opposite party no. 2 and
sufficient opportunity was granted to appear and raise necessary
objection, if any. However, till date there is no representation on
her part.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is ready and
