The petitioners would be more than happy if their representation contained in Annexure-7 is considered by the Principal Secretary, Revenue and Land Reforms, Government of Bihar.

The respondents in their counter affidavit have annexed Annexure-A/2, which is a decision rendered by the Principal Secretary, dated 14.02.2013. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the facts and the Rules, which govern their case is different.

Looking at the nature of the direction, which is being issued, the Court will intentionally refrain from accepting such a submission of the petitioner on the face value.

Let the Principal Secretary take cognizance of Annexure-7 and pass appropriate order preferably within a period of three months from the date of production of a copy of this order.
