ORAL ORDER

2 23-12-2016 Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No. 2 has been arrested, the application as against him has become infructuous and, therefore, he prays for leave of this Court to withdraw the same.

Leave is granted.

The application as against petitioner No. 2 is dismissed as infructuous.

So far as petitioner No. 1 is concerned, there is no specific allegation against her.

In view of the nature of allegations made and that the dispute has arisen only on account of tying of a cow at the door steps of the petitioner, let the petitioner abovenamed, in the event of her arrest / surrender within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on



bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad in connection with Jamhore P.S. Case No. 22/2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
