Petitioner submits that he has already obtained succession certificate from a competent court for getting the retrial dues.

Having regard to the aforesaid, this writ application is being disposed of with a direction to the respondent no. 2, the Director General of Police, Bihar, Patna, to take a decision in the matter of the petitioner in accordance with law if a representation is filed by the petitioner along with a copy of this order and necessary succession certificate and other relevant documents in

support of his claim for payment of the retiral dues of Late Pramila Jha, who had died in harness on 9.1.2009 working as constable within a period of two months from the date of receipt / production of a copy of this order. While doing he should also consider the claim of the petitioner who claims to be her adopted son.
