However, it is made clear that the petitioner would be

at liberty to raise all the issues which would be available to him at

the time of seeking regular bail including the observation of the

Sessions Judge that seizure was made on 28.03.2012 and papers

were put up before the Chief Judicial Magistrate on 05.02.2013

which was required to be put up within 24 hours.

It is further made clear that if the petitioner surrenders and seeks regular bail then the court below would consider his application on its own merit without being prejudiced by the present order.
