By way of the present application preferred under
Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners
seek quashing of the first information report of Dhanaha P.S. Case
No. 114 of 2015 dated 12.08.2015 registered under Sections 147,
148, 149, 341, 342, 333, 353, 453, 452, 354, 379, 323, 324, 325,

326, 307, 188, 504, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3(1)(x) of the Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the State and perused the allegations made in the FIR as contained in Annexure-1 to the present application. The allegations made therein do attract ingredients of cognizable offence.

In that view of the matter, I find no merit in this application. Accordingly, the application is dismissed.
