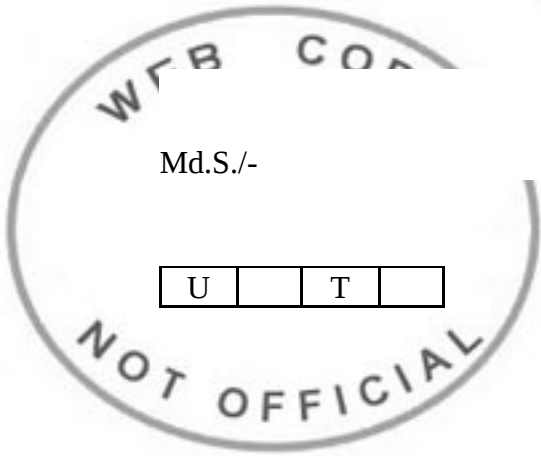
Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
