Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case under
Section 307, 323, 341, 147, 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant named the petitioner along with others
and alleged that Sudhir Singh and Ashok Singh assaulted him with
Lathi.

It is submitted that informant, Amod Singh, got two
lacerated wounds and nature of injury was kept reserved. The
informant did not go to A.N.M.C.H, Gaya for X-ray. Even the
doctor at Sadar Hospital, Aurangabad reported that the injuries are
simple in nature. It appears that only two lacerated wounds were
found and the injuries were superficial in nature.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the nature of

allegations made against the petitioner, the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt / production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad in Mali P.S. Case No. 35 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
