2 10-11-2016 Heard Sri Nityanand Neeraj, learned counsel for the

petitioner and learned Addl. Public Prosecutor.

The petitioner, husband of Opp.Party no.2, has
prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in Complaint Case
No.793/2013 registered for the offence under Sections 498(A),
494 of the Indian Penal Code.

It was submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that since from the first wife there was no issue, the
petitioner solemnized second marriage.

Keeping in view the fact that during the life time of
first wife, the petitioner solemnized second marriage as well as the

allegation under Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code, the petitioner being husband of the complainant is not entitled to be released on anticipatory bail.

The petition stands dismissed.
