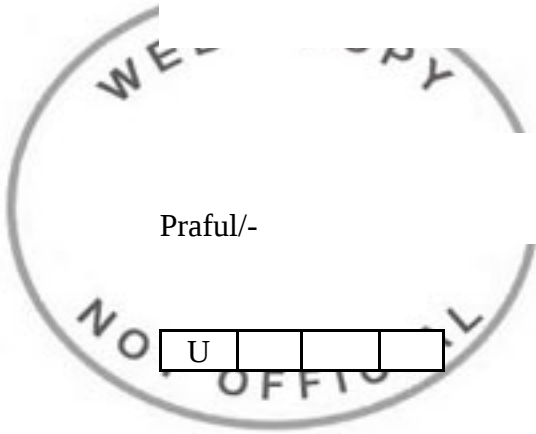
9 13-01-2016 Smt. Shaili Kumari, learned counsel for the petitioners,
