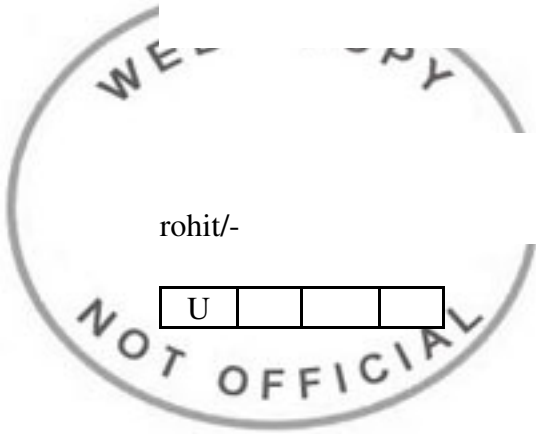

should represent before the competent/appropriate authority who
