Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a
case registered for the offences punishable under Sections
20(b) of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances
Act.

The prosecution case is that from the tobacco
shop of the petitioner, from a polythene 10 gm. ganja was
recovered.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the
petitioner that for a petty dispute with regard to giving
tobacco the case has been maliciously lodged. Statement
has been made in para-3 of the petition that petitioner has
no criminal antecedent.

Mr. Awadhesh Kumar, learned counsel for the State does not dispute the recovery of small quantity.

Considering the fact that small quantity of ganja has been recovered, it is a case for consideration of prayer for bail on surrender within a period of six weeks before the learned 3rd Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No. 26 of 2016.

With the above observation this application is disposed of.
