3 22-11-2016 Heard Sri Ajay Kumar Singh, learned counsel for the

petitioner and Smt. Sahin Begam, learned Additional Public

Prosecutor.

The petitioner , who is husband of the deceased has
prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in Harsidhi P.S. Case No. 127
of 2016 registered for offence under section 498-A, 304B / 34 of
the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 and 4 of the Dowry
Prohibition Act.

Sri Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner submits
that it was an accidental death but falsely informant has
implicated entire family member . He submits that marriage was
solemnized in the year 2011 and from the wedlock there were
two minor children and as such there was no occasion for the

petitioner to commit crime.

Besides hearing, I have perused the materials available on record.

In view of the nature of accusation I am not inclined to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail.

The petition stands dismissed.
