Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since in the writ application filed by Respondent No. 6,  
which was C. W. J. C. No. 25019 of 2013, decided on 08.01.2014,  
the Learned Single Judge categorically held that no direction can be  
issued for implementation of the order, passed by the tribunal, since  
it is bad, both in fact and law and the writ application was dismissed.

If that be so, then the petitioner succeeds, because the  
tribunal's order is not required to be implemented. No pressure can  
be brought upon her to implement the order and direction, which has

held to be bad in law.

Writ application stands allowed.
