accordingly he happens to be present before the Bench.

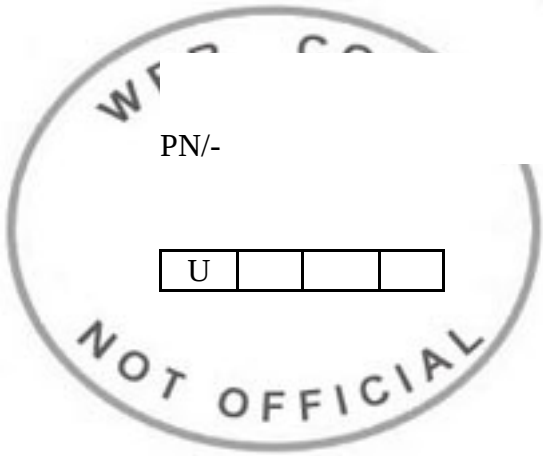
Furthermore, it has been submitted that from the show-cause it is
