2 30-09-2016 After some argument, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, in presence of the learned AC to GA 6 appearing on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 5, seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with a liberty to avail of the remedy of revision available to the petitioners, under the provisions of The Bihar Land Reforms (Fixation of Ceiling Area and Acquisition of Surplus Land), Act, 1961, against the impugned appellate order.

Permission is accorded.

The writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the

liberty aforesaid.
