Heard learned counsel for the parties.

No relief can be granted to the petitioner of benefit of 2nd time-bound-promotion in view of the stand emerging from paragraph nos. 7 and 8 of the counter affidavit. Claim of such benefit is regulated by certain rules, which are notified and is annexed as Annexure-A.

If the petitioner does not come within the zone of consideration, he cannot innovate or demand the benefit which



petitioner knows very well that he is not entitled to. Writ application is basically trying to take a chance, if not wagering before the High Court.

Writ application is dismissed.
