inadvertently the peremptory order dated 22.09.2014 has not been

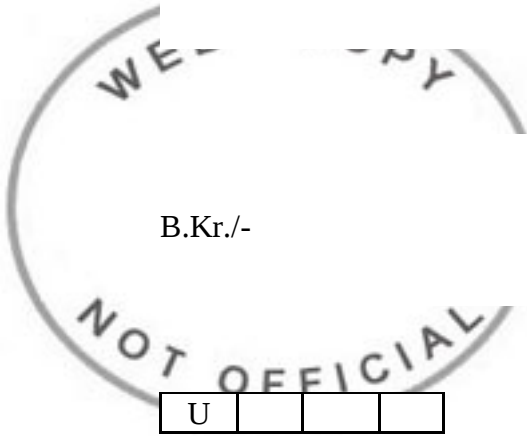
properly complied with as the requisites were not filed in correct
