2 21-12-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the
A.P.P. for the State.

This application is for grant of anticipatory bail for the
offence under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
from perusal of the FIR, it appears that the charge of forgery, as
alleged, is against Dr. Amiya Agrawal and not against the
petitioner and he has been falsely implicated in the present case
and only his name has been mentioned in the FIR.

Heard learned A.P.P., who could not controvert the
aforesaid fact that there is no specific allegation against this
petitioner.



Having heard both sides and considering the aforesaid facts of the matter, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of CJM, Nawada in connection with Nagar P.S.Case No.379 of 2016, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
