The dispute raised by the petitioner will not be decided under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, especially since there is a history of mutual settlement having been reached between parties and even benefit thereof has been derived by the petitioner. Now she cannot resile and turn around and claim a legal right ignoring the other aspect of settlement and agreement between the parties.

However, the Court does not prevent the petitioner from getting an appropriate declaration from a civil court of competent

jurisdiction.
