The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection
with Surajgarha P.S. Case No. 56 of 2015 registered under
Sections 302 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Regard being had to the fact that the petitioners were

police submitted final report showing them innocent and the co-

identical allegations have been granted privilege of pre-arrest bail by co-ordinate Benches of this Court vide order dated 04.01.2016 passed in Cr. Misc.
