Under the facts and circumstances under which mother of the petitioner was sanctioned family pension etc. enough compassion has been shown therein. The Court is not willing to expand the scope for compassionate appointment beyond a limit. Petitioner's father was a work charge employee and that has implications.

Writ is dismissed as no direction for compassionate appointment can be issued in the given facts.
