2 29-01-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
APP.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case filed under
Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is contended that the petitioner is the owner of the
pick-up van which was being driven by his father Rajendra
Sharma who has already been granted anticipatory bail. It is
contended that 59 bags of seized rice is not a stolen property and
petitioner has clean antecedent.

Having regards to the facts and circumstances of the
case, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks
from today in Madhepura P.S. Case No. 260 of 2015, the
petitioner above named shall be released on bail on furnishing bail

bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Madhepura, subject to the conditions as laid down under sub-section (2) of Section 438of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
