Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a
case registered for the offences punishable under Sections
326, 307/34, 120B of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the
Arms Act.

The prosecution case is that Nagendra Singh, the
father of the petitioner got the informant identified by two
unknown persons and subsequently one of the unknown
person caused fire-arm injury on the abdomen of the
informant. It is alleged against the petitioner that earlier
he threatened the informant.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the
petitioner that the accusation has been levelled in the
background of litigated relationship between the parties,

petitioner is agnate of the informant and serious land dispute is going on between the parties.

Considering the thrust of accusation against the co-accused, who resorted to fire and statement being made in para-3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the above named petitioner be released on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Danapur, Patna in connection with Rupaspur P.S. Case No. 209 of 2015, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
