ORAL JUDGMENT

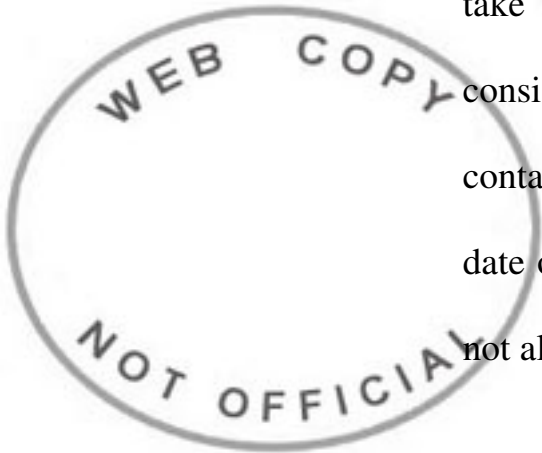
