2 14-12-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 295A/341/333/427 and other minor sections of the Indian Penal Code.

During cultural programme on the occasion of Durga Puja two groups of people scuffled and committed assault against each other. The petitioner was identified among the assailant.

Considering the nature of allegation and the materials, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory



bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Mr. Pradeep Kumar Chaudhary, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Uda Kishunganj/Successor Court in connection with Bihariganj Police Station Case No.171 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
