The grievance of the petitioner is that though the earlier order of refusal of arms licence to the petitioner has been set aside by the Appellate Authority and the matter was remitted back to the Licensing Authority for fresh consideration while allowing the appeal on 30.08.2011 itself, however, no decision has been taken as yet by the District Magistrate-cum-Licensing Authority, Patna.

Having regard to the aforementioned facts and circumstances, this writ application is being disposed of with a direction to the respondent no.3 to take a decision in the matter
