The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in public interest for directing the respondents to include the names of the residents of village-Parbatia @ Pokharia Kol of District-Nawada, who have submitted applications in prescribed forms for the inclusion of their names in the voter list.

We do not find that such direction is warranted in a public interest litigation, as the voter list is required to be corrected and updated under the Representation of People Act, 1951.

Since there is alternative procedure prescribed, we do



not find that the petitioner can be permitted to raise such grievance through invoking the public interest writ jurisdiction.

Accordingly, the writ application is dismissed.
