ORAL ORDER

3 17-11-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Phulparas P.S. Case No.48 of 2016 for allegedly having committed the offences under Sections 147, 148, 149, 353, 323, 427 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage of Public Property Act.

It appears from a perusal of the F.I.R. that there is general and omnibus allegation against all the accused persons. The allegation of having damaged electrical equipment to the tune of Rs.1,25,000/- is against all the accused and not against these petitioners in particular.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and also that the petitioners have no criminal antecedents, let all the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of ₹10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jhanjharpur, in connection with Phulparas P.S. Case No.48 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
