2 16-08-2016 I.A. No. 730 of 2016 has been filed by the appellant,

under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, seeking condonation of

delay of 58 days in preferring the present Letters Patent Appeal

against the order, dated 23.09.2015, passed by the learned Single

Judge in C.W.J.C. No. 8222 of 2011.

Heard Mr. Manoj Kumar Jha, learned Counsel,

appearing on behalf of the appellant. None has appeared on behalf

of the State-respondents though notices stand served.

Having considered the reasons assigned in the present petition seeking condonation of delay and having heard the learned counsel for the parties, this Court is satisfied that the appellant was prevented by sufficient causes from preferring the appeal within time.

In view of the above, the delay of 58 days, in preferring the Letters Patent Appeal, is hereby condoned.
