Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Jehanabad  
P.S. Case No. 282/2014 registered under Sections 406, 420/34 of  
the Indian Penal Code.

The informant alleged that he gave loan of rupees six  
lacs to his friend Sanjay Kumar, son of the petitioner, for  
construction of house which was to be returned within 1½ years.  
Sanjay Kumar prepared a document and put his signature on  
revenue stamp. It is submitted that Sanjay Kumar has not taken  
any money from the informant nor the petitioner put his signature  
on any paper. Sanjay Kumar, son of the petitioner, is said to have  
put his signature on the agreement.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named  
petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned

court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt / production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jehanabad in Jehanabad P.S. Case No. 282/2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
