petitioner and Sri Ram Naresh Ray, learned Addl. Public

Prosecutor.

The petitioner has prayed for grant of anticipatory
bail in Complaint Case No.248/2016, T.R. No.2730/2016
registered for the offence under Sections 323, 341, 379, 420,
498(A), 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, in which learned
Magistrate has taken cognizance of offence under Section 498(A)
of the Indian Penal Code and has directed for issuance of
summons.

Learned counsel for the petitioner accepts that after
