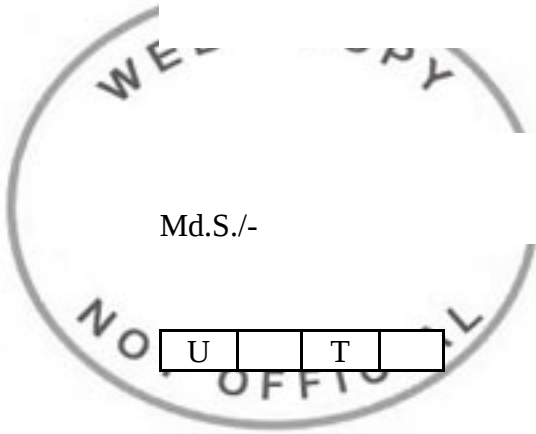
2 25-01-2016 By way of the present application preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks quashing of the first information report in connection with Kurhni P.S. Case No.21 of 2014 registered under Section 366A read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
