At the time of hearing of this I.A., on the request of the learned counsel for the petitioner, I heard the application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India on merit in admission matter.

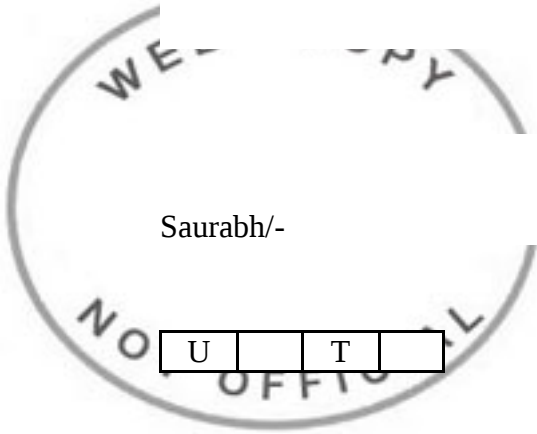
In this application, the petitioner is praying for a direction to the Court below to prepare decree and also to make available case record or reconstruct the file of the Partition Suit No.13 of 2009.
