Petitioners claim that the only reason why their claim for regularization was rejected was that there was no vacancy when the impugned order contained in Annexure-4 was passed in the year 2013. Since then they have inputs and information including Right to Information Act that vacancies are existing. Let the petitioners assert their right in this regard before the appropriate authority who is said to

be the Home Secretary, Government of Bihar which will be decided on the available facts and law within a reasonable time frame.

Writ application is disposed of with liberty as above.
